- ❖ **College Hill Lutheran Church** is linked to El Paso, Texas, where long-term missionary Naomi Valine serves. She shares, "The remainder of March was full of groups and work. We had two medical clinics, one vacation Bible school, and one house built in two weeks! Between the two clinics, approximately 750 patients were seen at three different mission churches. I helped translate for several days, and was able to watch as people who are too poor to see a doctor were able to receive vitamins, baby formula, and other necessary medical items that they can't otherwise purchase. The doctors prescribed and gave away piles and piles of medications, which I'm sure will make a significant difference in the lives of people struggling with high blood pressure, diabetes, infections, strep throat, and other common ailments that can be life-threatening if not treated. People were always there waiting for us when we pulled up in the morning, and some of them would be waiting for six hours or more to see the doctor!"

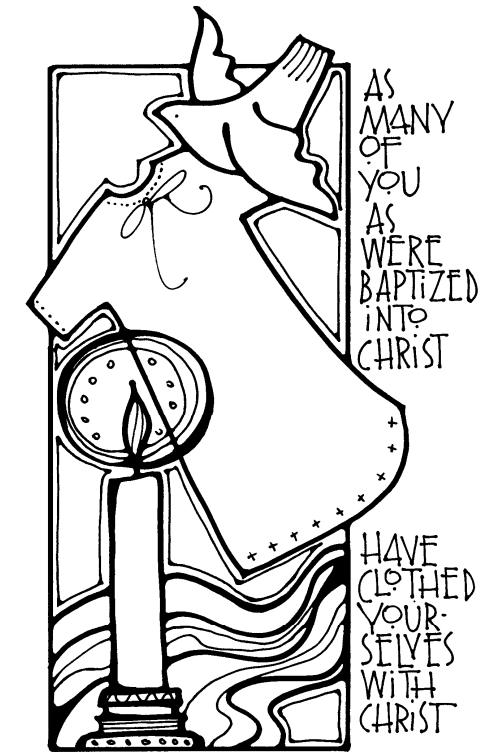
### PRAYER OPPORTUNITIES FOR THE WEEK OF JUNE 24, 2007
