Get ready! It's coming! The Thanksgiving Dinner is NEXT WEEK!

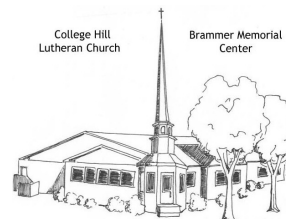
Join us for this annual event, complete with turkey, dressing and all the trimmings. The meal will follow worship on November 11. Invite your friends to join your for worship and dinner.
